Sir/Madam,

This is with reference to school application on the subject cited above. I am directed to convey the approval of the Board for Affiliation i.e Upgradation to Secondary Level as per details given below :

Sl. No.	The school is directed to ensure that :
1	The total number of section of the school shall be restricted to 44. Further increase of section shall be subject to specific approval of the Board on the basis of the request of the school as per affiliation bye laws and subject to the availability of room size of greater than 500 sq ft.
2	As seen in the RC video the construction work of some portion of the boundary wall is under process. Hence the school is directed to construct 6 feet boundary wall in all sides of the school campus and submit the compliance on SARAS portal within month.
3	The school does not have ramp / Lift to access upper floor, however the school has shown to RC members that the work for installation of lift is under process. Hence the school is directed to completion the lift work within 3 month and submit the compliance in SARAS portal.
4	A wheel chair cannot be entered into the cubicles of CWSN toilets due to positioning of the seat and the handles. Moreover the handles have sharp edges which may cause safety hazard to a disable person. The school is directed to upgrade the CWSN toilet as per circular no 5/2023 and submit the compliance on SARAS portal within month.
5	As reported by RC, the school has breached the essential factor of privacy while constructing the urinals for girls. Hence the school is directed to make proper

	partitions to maintain the privacy of girl's toilets and submit the compliance on SARAS portal within month.
6	6. The indoor sports facilities are seen inadequate and some of the sports items are on floor. Hence the school is directed to upgrade the sports facilities as per SoP issued by the Board and submit the compliance on SARAS portal within month.
7	The composite science lab does not have proper fittings/installations, work stations. Seating capacity is less in Maths lab. Hence the school is directed to upgrade the labs as per Sop issued by the Board and submit the compliance within 3 months on SARAS portal.
8	The total land area mentioned in the OASIS 37248 sq mt whereas as per previous land certificate the land area of the school mentioned 35167.18 sq. mtrs which includes the land area for two schools. Now the school has provided revised land certificate for this school and the area is mentioned as 18413.20 sq mt. Hence the school is directed to apply on SARAS portal for decreased of land area in OASIS as per revised land certificate.
9	The school shall conduct training of its teachers with CoE Vijayawada within 3 months and submit the compliance.

Compliance of the above mentioned points shall be submitted within 03 months on the SARAS Portal. Failure to comply within the prescribed time shall invite financial penalty @ Rs. 50,000/- every month until compliance is submitted and shall debar the school from filling the registration and LOC of students class IX to class XII , as the case may be.

The approval of the Board as mentioned above, is subject to the following conditions:-

1. The school shall be responsible for its genuineness of the documents/ data/ information uploaded by the school. In case of any discrepancies, action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Bye -Laws-2018.
2. The school shall follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned.
3. The School shall apply online for extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws.
4. The school shall go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and subsequent amendment therein as well as circulars and guidelines /instructions issued by the Board time to time and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and is also advised to regularly visit CBSE websites i.e., <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates.
5. The school shall renew mandatory certificates from time to time.
6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
7. Concerned Regional Office is requested to create new email id of school as per direction issued by controller of examination. This E Mail ID is used for communication with CBSE only.
8. The school shall not remove the documents and videography links in the mandatory disclosure section of its website.
9. The school shall follow the SOPs of the Board for its Laboratories, Library and sports facilities issued by the Board vide circular no 11 dated 04.10.2022.

If the compliance is not submitted with in the stipulated 3 months , the Board may enhance the penalty amount and debar the schools from filling up registration/LOC details of students of classes IX to XII, as the case may be, in the next academic session i.e. 2024-25.
